- Katie McVicker (katie.mcviker@seattle.gov) and Jason Sharpley (jason.sharpley@seattle.gov), Seattle Public Utilities (www.seattle.gov/util), Taylor Creek Culvert Replacement (aka Lower Taylor Creek Habitat Restoration) Project – The project will improve the creek channel and surrounding habitat, improve fish passage, address storm-related flooding and sediment deposition at the mouth of the creek, provide public access to the new natural area north of Rainier Ave S, and construct corridor safety improvements in coordination with SDOT.
