Other Items Discussed:

- Jackie provided an update from the 2 open houses hosted by the <u>Kubota Garden</u> Foundation's and their 30-40 year master plan for improvements An advisory committee, of which Jackie is a member, is compiling comments from the community from which they will develop recommendations to the Foundation. There are 2 potential state grants available (totaling \$1.2M) for bathrooms and accessibility. The Committee supports no-charge access.
- Tom provided an update of the <u>air quality monitoring project</u>. The monitoring equipment requires an outside electrical outlet. He is not sure if our center has that. Another neighbor attending the meeting volunteered the use of his property for the monitoring if need be. UW will reimburse the \$3.46 estimated electricity charge.
- Tom reminded folks of event on July 21 10-4 at Farm Fest at Urban Farm Wetlands.

- Danielle from Rainier View neighborhood advised members that Se attle Parks Department plans to build a <u>second entrance to Dead Horse Canyon</u>. Danielle and Tom will coordinate on how to have a say.

- Danielle also announced the annual <u>Back-to-School Bash</u> on August 11 (noon-4). Among other things, it provides back-packs and supplies to Rainier Beach families. The RBCC membership agreed to contribute \$500 to this worthy cause.
