<u>Featured Speaker.</u> - Emily Parzybok, Campaign Manager of "Yes!", spoke in support of a \$213M, 7 year levy for the Seattle Library system. Vote is on 8/6/19. The levy will enable Library to expand hours, its print and digital collection and other services. It will also fund seismic retrofitting for older libraries. They are looking for volunteers to talk to voters.

Alan reported that the <u>URB garden tour</u> was a great success, with 119 registered guest senjoying the 10 gardens on the tour. He is looking for a new committee to head this in 2020.

Natalya updated members on Inland Development Group'plans in RB. <u>HK Seafood will be torn down and</u> replaced with a 360 unit apartment building (60% AMI – affordable for middle income). There will be a 6000 sq ft spacestreet level occupied by NW Black Pioneers (day care and other community services). Start of construction will be 4Q19 and the developers seek community input via a survey that will be distributed via RBCC and at FarmFest.
