## RBCC BOARD MEETING 3/26/25

Board approved minutes from its 2/26/25 meeting.

Discussion items (Action Items in **Bold Italic**)

- 1. Review of recent RBCC events:
  - a. 3/1 Game Night Around 20 attendees 3 mahjongg tables. Lotsa fun.
  - b. <u>Meaningful Movies</u>, "Free for All": The Public Library, Sat., 3/8. Also had speakers from Seattle Libraries and UW. About 30 in attendance
  - c. Vanishing Seattle talk and film at member meeting was well attended (30). These fun topics are attracting people who don't normally come to our meetings.
- 2. Updates on upcoming RBCC events:
  - a. 4/17 Beach Talk Need topic and publicity materials from Marcus ASAP.
  - b. 4/19 Plant and Seed Share
  - c. 7/12 Day of Service. *Anne, Nancy and Jessica agreed to host* a modified version of this focusing on neighborhood clean-up, without formally assigned areas like stairs, etc. *Alan agreed to participate in a planning meeting. Gerd will help get RBCC signed up with the City. Su and Gerd will submit the grant request.*
  - d. 7/13 Garden Stroll
- 3. Committee assignments, pending approval at next member meeting:

- 4. Updates on window and curtain projects:
  - a. **Su will get clarification on window** quote she recently received (4 or. 5 windows)
  - b. Su said relined curtains will be done in early April
  - c. Thanks to Gerd for getting new curtains for entryway and chair room windows from Ikea.
  - d. Board decided to pause on new red velvet curtains for remaining windows until we know what grant money we have available.
- 4. Next steps on \$200K 4Culture grant opportunity.
  - a. **Gerd is drafting our grant application (Anne and Nancy will proof**). Our stated long-term focus is making the clubhouse AD accessible. To that end, our grant request seeks about \$200K for:
    - 1. Electrical upgrades (\$50K est.)
    - 2. Replace oil furnace with 2 heat pumps (\$50-60K est.)
    - 3. Interior/exterior paint (\$10-20K est.)

- 4. Estimates for windows, bath and roof are TBD
- b. VFW likes our plan and is willing to contribute funds. *Su and Gerd will ask VFW to split the 20% contribution* that 4Culture requires from its grant recipients.
- c. Su confirmed that RBCC has right of first refusal in perpetuity and that it is in the title. This is in effect 5 years after the most recent lease is signed.
- d. 4Culture also requires that RBCC can show that we can show "site control" over the clubhouse for at least 10 years. Gerd said that RBCC is signing a 5 lease effective May 2025, with a 5 year extension opportunity. VFW is willing to hold our rent at \$700/month for the whole 10 years if we get the grant.
- 5. Alan said that the publicity guidelines have been updated and encourages all to use them.
- 6. The Board agreed to Seattle Parks and Recreation's request for a letter from RBCC endorsing its plan to purchase the property at 11425 69th PI S, Seattle which will enable it to offer a trailhead into the south end of Deadhorse Canyon park. SPR needs at least 2 such letters from neighborhood groups in order to get grant \$ from KC Conservation Futures to purchase a property. *Anne will draft said letter and route it to the Board and get Marcus to sign it.*
