### **CLUB BUSINESS**

1. Update on building improvements – Gerd reported that RBCC's grant request for \$220K from 4 Culture was unsuccessful. RBCC will continue to apply for neighborhood grants, including a \$50K grant request from the City's Dept. Of Neighborhoods to fund electrical upgrades for the clubhouse and possibly a \$5K grant to replace some windows.

### **TONIGHT'S SPEAKERS**

RBCC hosted a Meet the Candidates forum featuring Eddie Lin and Adonis Ducksworth who are running for City Council District 2. Moderated by Glenda Graham-Walton, each candidate was given 5 minutes for opening statements, followed by a 20-30 minute audience Q & A and candidate closing statements. The candidates fielded questions on a variety of topics including housing, affordability, gun violence, the City's policies on ICE, Medicaid access, tree preservation and the City's budget shortfall.
