Asia Tail, Yəhaw' Indigenous Creatives Collective <https://yehawshow.com>

yəhaw' Indigenous Creatives Collective is a community of intertribal Indigenous artists rematriating 1.5 acres of land in South Seattle, on Coast Salish territories. Its mission is to help improve Indigenous well-being through art-making, community building, and equitable creative opportunities for personal and professional growth.

Since its founding in 2017, this Lushootseed traditional narrative has inspired the values and practices of yəhaw' Indigenous Creatives Collective. Located at 9658 51st Ave S, they were able to obtain the land with a \$2M Miracle Grant from the City

Asia reviewed the group's history, plans for the campus and the various activities they sponsor. All are welcome to explore the campus anytime (it is staffed on Fridays from 10-2 from March through October). Asia reported that so far, at least 2900 have visited.
