Board approved minutes from its 3/25/26 meeting.

Discussion items (Action Items in ***Bold Italic***)

1. Recaps on recent RBCC events:
  - a. April member meeting speaker - Marissa London - Habitat for Humanity. She was well prepared, lots of questions from members.
  - b. Plant and Seed Share 4/18 – Well attended and all plants were taken.
  - c. Jazz Jam on 4/19 - Great attendance, their programming this year looks great. Piano bench is broken. The piano is 90 years old. Piano tuner Jerry Anderson tuned it in 2023 and said it is not worth doing again. We need to ask the VFW if we can remove it. Discussion about whether the club needs a piano or whether the Jazz Jam should deal with getting one if they need it. ***Gerd will talk to VFW and also Mike Yaksutake and see what the Jazz Jam needs/thoughts are moving forward.***
