

RBCC BOARD MEETING 6/24/26

Board approved minutes from its 5/27/26 meeting.

Discussion items (Action Items in ***Bold Italic***)

1. Recaps on recent RBCC events:
 - a. Garden Stroll - 6/7. 100+ attendees even though date coincided with many HS graduations.
 - b. Jazz Jam "A Salute to Dads", Sunday, 6/21. No one from Board able to attend.
2. Updates on upcoming RBCC events
 - a. Beach Talk - Where is AI going? 7/9
 1. ***Jessica to provide Marcus with materials so that he can post FB and Insta announcements.***
 - b. Ice Cream / Jazz Social on 8/16. Jessica got 2-day City permit for RBCC and HUB. HUB agreed to pick up and return City's signs (RBCC will pay for these signs). After the meeting Jessica and Kathie determined that the City permits closing Pilgrim for the Ice Cream Social and the HUB Emergency Drill did not require the City be named an additional insured on the RBCC insurance. The HUB is taking out event insurance for the Drill and is including RBCC as an additional insured on that policy ***Kathie will get HUB's Cert. of Insurance and Jessica will provide Gerd with permit.***
3. Discussion Topics and Action Items:
 - a. Update on building electrical project – Gerd reported contractor signed contract and cashed our 50% down-payment. He agreed to get permit. Don't know start date yet but project should take a couple of weeks.
 - b. New piano update – Kathie reports that Jazz Jam is looking for a new piano, cost not to exceed \$5K including freight and disposal.
 - c. Ron is applying for a grant to help with promotional materials for the emergency drill in August. RBCC has agreed to be the fiscal sponsor.
 - d. Update from insurance agent re HUB becoming part of RBCC. Initial feedback from broker is that our insurance underwriter will not cover the HUB as part of RBCC. Kathie and Gerd are seeking more clarity from the underwriter on why this is.
 - e. Insurance requirements for private event renters. Seeking clarification on this - we may not need it for non-recurring rentals. Also need to understand if insurance allows alcohol at RBCC events.
 - f. ***Jessica to see if she could move her 9/12 Meaningful Movie on deported US veterans to 11/14 to follow Veteran's Day which is on Wednesday,***

11/11. As this is the same day as our member meeting, we want to make sure to acknowledge veterans and announce the Meaningful Movie.
